

# **REVIEWER CODER MANUAL**

National Mexican

## **Presentation**

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The **National Institute of Statistics, Geography and Computer Science (INEGI)** presents the **Guide of Codification of the National Mexican Health and Aging Study (MHAS-2003)**.

The purpose of this document is to serve as a basic tool, so that the information collected in the questionnaire MHAS-2003 will be coded correctly to facilitate its processing and publication.

## **Introduction**

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The goal of this guide is to present the criteria that have been used to correctly assign codes for MHAS.

The document addresses those taking part in the survey and mainly the reviewer-coders, who are responsible for the analysis of information and the assignment of codes.

With this guide we expect to make clear what the acceptable codes are for each of the questions, and in some cases the specifications needed in order to assign codes correctly and efficiently. The general recommendations to follow during the coding phase are detailed at the very beginning of this guide.

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## **I. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE REVIEWER-CODER**

The task of the reviewer-coder is to review and analyze the information captured by the interviewer. The reviewer-coder must look at the information thoroughly, making sure that it is neither superfluous nor insufficient; that the sequences used are the proper ones; and that the information recorded for each question is correct and consistent. This process ensures that all the information is complete, logical, and congruent, in order to facilitate the codification process.

Given the importance of reviewing-coding, it is crucial that the persons performing this task are thoroughly acquainted with the structure, functioning, and goals of the survey, besides being responsible, analytical, critical and organized.

The functions of the reviewer-coder consist of revising, validating, and coding the information. In order to do so, we recommend bearing in mind the following general rules:

### **Review**

- Review the material to ensure it is complete, matching the interview results with the amount and type of received questionnaires.
- If the interview results key does not match the interviews and types of collected questionnaires, you must correct the key as a control measure (determine if it is the case of single or couple interview).
- Before analyzing the questionnaires, verify if in the observation section there are any annotations that can help complement the accepted information.
- Ask the supervisor if you have any doubts when analyzing the information.
- When you find a mistake, look at the rest of the information to determine if it can be corrected. Never erase the original information if you correct something.
- Compare the information when verifying the congruence of each section.
- The person must have information in Section "L" if he/she was selected for anthropometric measures.

### **Validation**

It is indispensable to review and check the information thoroughly in order to validate it. You must have corrected all the mistakes found. Mark all the correct answers with red ink.

Invalidate all the incorrect answers by crossing two red lines on the answer.

### **Coding**

Coding is assigning alphanumeric symbols to the information captured in the survey. MHAS involves different types of

questions: pre-coded, direct coding, multiple choice, etc. We must establish how to proceed in each case.

- In pre-coded questions there is no need for remarking the data obtained in the survey. In this case validation of that data is sufficient.
- Make the necessary calculation for coding years, quantities and dates, and use the corresponding spaces when applicable.
- Code the precise validated answers
- Use red ink when coding.
- Write clear and legible numbers in order to avoid later mistakes in the typing phase.

**THE REVIEWER-CODER MUST INVALIDATE ALL THE CODES THAT CORRESPOND TO INTERVIEW CONTROL (CROSS THEM OUT USING TWO DIAGONAL LINES) TO ENSURE THAT THESE ARE NOT RECORDED AS DATA, WHICH WOULD DISTORT THE CODIFICATION.**

## **II. SPECIFIC INDICATIONS FOR THE REVIEWER-CODER**

### **A. TITLE PAGE**

#### **-Identification Numbers**

The coder must write the identification numbers from the household list: **No. de vivienda seleccionada, unique ID key 2001, actualiza hogar y resultado de la entrevista (que obtendra del reverso de la hoja muestra)**. The reviewer-coder must verify that no number is omitted, and that the numbers and letters are legible

#### **NAME AND CODE OF INTERVIEWER, SUPERVISOR, AND CODER**

The reviewer-coder must verify that the name is written in legible letters with a one-digit code.

Chief Supervisor of Area = 1

Supervisor = 2

Coder = 3 and 4 (If there is only one coder, code 4 will be assigned to the Interviewer)

Interviewer = 5 to 9

#### **COORDINATES**

Verify that the latitude consists of 6 digits and the longitude of 7 digits, and enter zeroes where necessary. Investigate the latitude and longitude of the particular state and establish its limits.

**INDICATE IF THE LOCATION OF THIS INTERVIEW IS THE SAME AS MHAS 2001.**

Through these coordinates we intend to find out whether the respondent remained in the same home as MHAS 2001. If this is the case, mark 1; if not, mark 2 (change of home) and update address in corresponding space.

If respondents provide the year in which they started smoking (1970), subtract the year of birth to obtain the age at which the person started smoking.
